- a. Traffic Committee Proposed Resolution to the City Commission:
Be it resolved, the city commission hereby approves the traffic committee's recommendation to install stop signs at E. Sixth Street and Blair Avenue to create a four-way stop intersection, to install "all-way" plaques on all four stop signs, and to install a stop sign for northbound S. Altadena Avenue and S. Rembrandt Avenue traffic at E. Fifth Street, as outlined in agenda item 6a.
 - b. The Traffic Committee Proposed Resolution to the City Commission:
Be it resolved, the city commission hereby approves the traffic committee's recommendation to move the "no parking" signs for northbound and southbound traffic on N. Altadena Avenue south of 12 Mile Road to be 25 feet south of the current locations, and to move the existing stop bar on N. Altadena Avenue at the 12 Mile Road intersection to be 10 feet north, as outlined in agenda item 6b.
 - c. Traffic Committee Resolution to the City Commission:
Be it resolved, the city commission hereby approves the traffic committee's recommendation to install one "No parking beyond sign" sign just east of the 1918 E. Lincoln driveway, install one "No parking this side of sign" sign just west of the 2002 E. Lincoln driveway, install one "No parking this side of sign" sign just east of the 1923 E. Lincoln driveway and install one "No parking beyond sign" sign just west of the 2007 E. Lincoln driveway; to prepare a survey or other outreach method to obtain neighborhood opinions regarding pedestrian refuge islands, bike lanes, and/or parking changes prior to designing the 2032 road project on E. Lincoln Avenue; to direct staff to evaluate and implement additional striping of E. Lincoln Avenue parking lanes to clarify they are not travel lanes as outlined in agenda item 6c.
