AGENDA ITEMS:*

- 195-23. Councilor Fleming on behalf of several residents, employee's and non-residents of Fitchburg, Ma. A petition to add streetlights or roundabout to the intersection of North Street / John Fitch Highway and Pearl Hill Rd / John Fitch Highway to mitigate traffic concerns (accidents) and pedestrian crossing (safety) during daytime hours.
With the increase in traffic this discussion needs to take place before a tragedy occurs.
- 203-23. Remove the current no parking area on the east side of Snow St. (Snow Street East from Cherry Street to opposite Union Street) and replacing it with time limit parking (Two Hour Parking) to add ten new parking spots.
- 044-24. Marisa Fleming on behalf of Maritza Rivera of 478 Pearl St to install a blind driveway sign. This is to ensure oncoming vehicles traveling in both directions of Pearl St are aware of this hidden driveway. To also change the thru way between the monument and the house from a two way street to a one way street entering one way from Pearl St to Townsend St.
- 045-24. Councilors Marisa Fleming and Beth Walsh, on behalf of Lisa Bailey, to install additional stop signs at the intersection of Billings Road and Arn-How Farm Road, to make the intersection of Billings Road and Arn-How Farm Road a 3-way stop.
