#### **Executive Session**

The only time a Council meeting can be closed to the public is when the Council votes for Executive Session in order to discuss sensitive matters in private, such as pending litigation. Any votes taken however, must be taken in open session.

### OPPORTUNITIES FOR THE PUBLIC TO SPEAK DURING A COUNCIL MEETING:

#### **Public Forum**

The Public Forum occurs immediately following the Pledge of Allegiance. The President will ask if anyone in the audience wishes to speak on any matter appearing on the Agenda. If you wish to address the Council, you must stand and be recognized and follow these rules before speaking:

- 1. State your name and city of residence.
- 2. Approach the center table and either stand or sit. This allows you to be seen and heard clearly by everyone in attendance.
- 3. You may speak only on items appearing on the agenda for no more than (2) minutes. Copies of the agenda are available on the center table prior to the meeting.
- 4. Please state the petition, order, ordinance, or resolution number to which you refer.

#### **Public Hearings**

Public hearings are held on various issues such as Special Permits and Zoning changes. The same rules apply with the following exceptions:

- 1. You must stand and be recognized either "in favor" or "in opposition" when asked by the Council President.
- 2. You need not refer to the petition number.

If you have any questions or comments either before or after the meeting, any Councilor would be happy to assist you.

Oral Report

ORDER THAT: there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$150,000) from RESERVE FOR OTHER MUNICIPAL PURPOSES – Capital Expenses to SCHOOL BUILDING MAINTENANCE – Capital Improvement.

(Be Adopted)

O68-25. Fire Chief Suarez, to petition for an increase on the annual License fee for the Fire Alarm System monitoring from the current rate of \$200.00 to \$300.00. This increase will take effect January 1, 2026.

We request these funds be deposited into an a enterprise revolving fund for equipment maintenance and future upgrades.

This fee is charged annually through the City Clerk's Office Fire Dept. for all Fire Alarm Systems that are monitored by the Fitchburg Fire Department Dispatch Center, twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week.

## VII. ORDERS - FINANCE

- 071-25. ORDER THAT: the City of Fitchburg hereby transfers the sum of NINE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$9,500) from HEALTH Travel & Meetings Expense to HEALTH -RUBBISH REMOVAL Cleanup Funds.
- 072-25. ORDER THAT: there be and is appropriated from AVAILABLE FUNDS the sum of TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$20,000) for HEALTH RUBBISH REMOVAL Cleanup Funds.
- ORDER THAT: the City of Fitchburg hereby approves the expenditure of grant funds from the Massachusetts Department of Transportation Complete Streets Funding Program, in the approximate amount of FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY-SIX THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE DOLLARS (\$456,121) to support pedestrian projects on Summer Street and at Electric Avenue and Rollstone Road.
- ORDER THAT: the City of Fitchburg hereby approves the expenditure of earmark funds from the Executive Office of Housing & Livable Communities in the approximate amount of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$250,000) to support the conversion of vacant upper-story space in downtown into housing.
- ORDER THAT: the City of Fitchburg hereby approves the expenditure of funds from Round 2 of the Department of Fire Services Firefighter Safety Equipment Grant in the approximate amount of FIVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY-TWO AND 33/100 DOLLARS (\$5,452.33) for the purpose of purchasing handheld thermal imaging cameras.
- ORDER THAT: the City of Fitchburg hereby appropriate and transfer the sum of THREE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$350,000) from Available Funds to the Stabilization Fund.
- ORDER THAT: the City of Fitchburg hereby appropriate and transfer the sum of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$250,000) from Available Funds to the Other Post-Employment Benefits (OPEB) Trust Fund.
- ORDER THAT: there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$400,000) same to be charged against AVAILABLE FUNDS and credited to DPW ADMIN/ENGINEERING EXPENSES Stormwater Contract Services.
