

Results of the February 16, 2016 Regular City Council Meeting

Consent Agenda: All items approved

Old Business:

- A. Approval of Ordinance O-2-16 Amending Bowie City Code Chapter 2, "Administration", Article II, "Personnel System", to Provide for an Appeal to the Court of Special Appeals from the Final Judgement of the Circuit Court in a Case Arising from a Decision by the Board of Personnel Appeals – Public Hearing held. Councilmember Esteve made a motion to approve Ordinance O-2-16, Councilmember Marcos seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

New Business:

- A. Environmental Initiatives – Mr. Gary Allen, Chair for the Bowie Environmental Advisory Committee updated Council on their 2016 initiatives toward a Green Bowie.
- B. Police Department Update – Police Chief John Nesky briefed Council on status of call center, police activities and body cameras. Mr. Chris Lindenau with Utility, Inc. gave a brief presentation on the body cameras and software being offered to the Police Department.
- C. Mid-Year Budget Review - City Manager Deutsch updated Council on the status of the City's finances and objectives as of December 31, 2015. General Fund Revenues are 3.9% more than at this time last year and expenditures are 12% higher.
