Old Business:

A. Adoption of Resolution R-50-21 Awarding a Contract to the University of Baltimore Jacob France Institute to Prepare an Economic Development Strategy and Action Plan – This resolution voids out Resolution R-46-21 which was adopted at the July 6, 2021 Council Meeting. New Business:

- A. **Bowie Loan Programs Briefing** Ms. Shelly Gross Wade, President of FSC First, Inc. presented on the different programs they have provided to Bowie Businesses during COVID.
- B. **Bowie Golf Course** City received two proposals for the management of the Golf Course. Councilmember Esteve motioned to have Council hold a Special Meeting on Tuesday, July 13 at 8:00 p.m. virtually, to go into Closed Session for discussions on the contract and then reconvene into open session to award contract. Councilmember Woolfley second the motion. Motion passed 6-0.
