Background:

The budget process in Yarmouth begins with a draft proposal prepared by the Town Manager and the School Superintendent. From there, both the Town Council and the School Committee review the draft budgets in detail, analyzing priorities, revenue projections, and funding needs. Through discussion and deliberation, each body develops recommended operating and capital improvement budgets.

This meeting is the second of two public hearings, where public comment is collected. If necessary, adjustments may be made prior to the annual Town Meeting.
